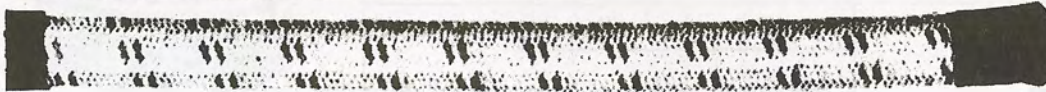


DOUBLE COVER (SHOCK CORD)

HEAVY DUTY ELASTIC



Shock Cords are made of multiple rubber strands encased in one or two braided covers. They keep taut cargo, gear, equipment, furniture, life boat covers, etc. Tie-downs stay taut under ordinary strain and expand to meet sudden extremes of wind, sea, rain...then instantly contract to their original tautness.

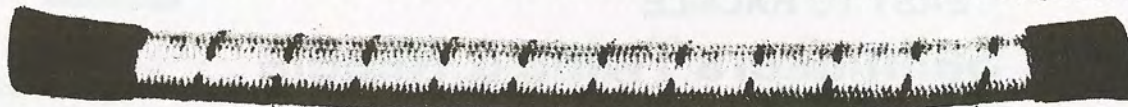

Commercial Grade—Cotton:

#1953—5/16" (150' spool); #1954—3/8" (100' spool); #1955—1/2" (100' spool)

Specification Grade—Nylon:

#69 — 1/4" (150 ft. spool); 5/16", 3/8", and 1/2" (100 ft. spools)

Cotton shock cords have inner cover of soft yarn, outer cover of glazed yarn. Nylon shock cords have two braided nylon covers. Double cover cords should be used where there is heavy tension or risk of abrasion.

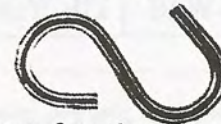

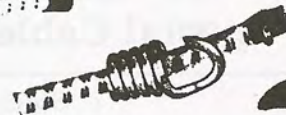
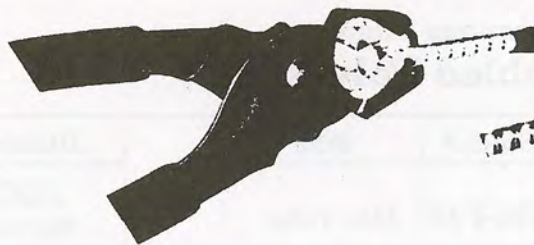


S—HOOKS
